Course Description

The aim of the course is to teach students to understand topical matters, and explain their opinions and advantages and disadvantages of a situation; read and understand routine information and articles and the meaning of information in a familiar area; and produce written work on a range of subjects.

Objectives of the Course:

- to understand the main points of clear standard input on familiar matters regularly encountered in work, school, leisure, etc.
- to deal with most situations likely to arise whilst travelling in an area where the language is spoken
- to produce simple connected text on topics which are familiar or of personal interest
- to describe experiences and events, dreams, hopes, ambitions and briefly give reasons and explanations for opinions and plans
- to produce clear, detailed text on a wide range of subjects and explain a viewpoint on a topical issue giving the advantages and disadvantages of various options
