

UNIVERSITY OF KYRENIA MAKE-UP EXAM REGULATIONS

Article-1 Make-up exams are held on the dates announced by each Faculty, School and Vocational School on their own websites.

Article-2 Only students studying in associate degree and undergraduate programmes will benefit from the make-up exam right. English Preparatory School and graduate programmes are excluded.

Application Guidelines

Article-3 Students who take the final exam of the courses they have taken in the semester and receive FF or FD as a result of the final exam have the right to make-up exam for each course.

Article-4 The make-up exam can only replace the final exam at the end of the semester and the new final letter grade is recalculated by taking into account the midterm grades before the final exam and the make-up grade.

Article-6 The continuation or termination of the scholarships of the students in ÖSYM scholarship and other full scholarship programmes is not based on the final exam grade point averages at the end of the semester, but is recalculated according to the grades obtained in the Make-up Exam.

Article-7 Make-up exams are not excused.

Article-8 There is no right to make-up exam for courses that do not have a written final exam and for which a final grade is given for the semester.

Article-9 Students who do not attend classes regularly during the semester, who do not take midterm exams and whose semester grade is "NA" (No-attendance) cannot benefit from the make-up exam right.

Article-10 Students with a semester grade point average of less than 2.00 can take the make-up exam from the courses they have taken in that semester and whose semester grades are not "NA" (No-attendance); Students with a semester grade point average of more than 2.00 cannot take the make-up exams from the courses they have passed in order to raise their grade.

Article-11 Students who want to benefit from the right to make-up exam must submit their petitions stating which courses they want to take the exam from to the Faculty Deans' Offices, School and Vocational School Directorates as soon as possible after the final results are announced.

Article-12 Students who have no debt can benefit from Make-up Exams.

Article-13 This Directive enters into force on 1 September 2016.
