UNIVERSITY OF KYRENIA Uniform Directive for Maritime Faculty Students

Objective:

The aim of this study is to determine the principles of uniform application, which constitutes an important part of Maritime Education, which is a special education, and aims to provide students with a sense of discipline and belonging and the ability to obey the rules.

Scope:

This regulation is applicable to students studying at the University of Kyrenia Faculty of Maritime Studies in the departments of Deck, Marine Engineering, Marine Engineering, Marine Management and Maritime Business and Management, and to students studying at the Faculty of Maritime Studies at the University of Kyrenia Faculty of Maritime Studies in the departments of Deck, Marine Engineering and Marine Management.

For this purpose, it covers students studying at the Preparatory School.

Duration and Application:

Students are obliged to wear uniforms from the beginning of the academic year until the end of the academic year. Wearing uniform during the internship periods is under the authority and responsibility of the relevant ship captain or maritime management. The uniform is to be worn during all lectures, exams and practice hours at the university. Students without uniform are not allowed to attend lectures, exams and practical trainings.

Between 2 November-30 April (inclusive), winter (navy blue) uniform will be worn, and between 2 May-31 October, summer (white) uniform will be worn. Training uniform (khaki coloured) may be worn during the practices to be carried out on ships. Hats will be worn in open areas inside and outside the university.

General Behaviour in Uniform:

A complementary part of the uniform is the general dress and behaviour of the students. Male students of the Faculty of Maritime Studies shave their hair so that it does not extend beyond the hat. Apart from this, they cannot grow hair or grow a beard. They must shave their beard every day.

Female students should have short hair or wear their hair pulled back and should not wear excessive make-up or jewellery.

While students are in uniform, they act in accordance with the requirements of this uniform; they may not engage in excessive behaviour or take part in activities such as mass demonstrations, boycotts, etc. organised by other students.

Uniform

Uniforms are determined as follows and shall be in accordance with Turkish maritime traditions:

With the uniform, a navy blue jumper may be worn during classroom hours.

Authorisations and Responsibilities :

The Dean's Office of the Faculty of Maritime Studies is responsible for the implementation of this regulation and the Dean's Office has the authority to impose penalties for students who behave inappropriately in uniform or who deliberately do not comply with the rules.
