

**UNIVERSITY OF KYRENIA**  
**SUMMER SCHOOL REGULATIONS**

a) The academic calendar for Summer School is determined with the approval of the Senate. Each course offered in the summer school is made up to the total course hours in the regular semesters.

b) Summer School is considered as a separate semester apart from the autumn and spring semesters. Students' grade point averages of the summer school are evaluated separately at the end of the summer school.

c) During the Summer School, all the facilities of the University of Kyrenia are available to students. The Library, Dormitories, Innovation Centre, laboratories are open and students can enjoy social and cultural activities.

d) The Summer School also offers the opportunity to take courses with other university students.

**Objective**

**Article 2**

a) To ensure that students take the courses they have taken and failed in previous semesters,

b) Students more previous periods and take it, enough level  
To ensure that they take the courses that they cannot succeed,

c) To enable students to take courses in a way that prevents the loss of semesters, thus, on the one hand, to give unsuccessful students the opportunity to repeat the courses they have failed, to provide successful students with the opportunity to graduate in a shorter period of time, on the other hand, to make idle physical resources productive during the holiday months and to prevent accumulation in the autumn and spring semesters.

### **Principles Regarding Summer School**

**Article-3 a )** Undergraduate courses to be offered in summer school are determined by the decision of the relevant department and faculty board of directors.

b) Undergraduate and associate degree students can register for a maximum of 12 credits/3 courses in summer school. In the summer school, students can also enrol in courses that they have not taken in previous courses or are planned to be opened in the next semester. After the courses start, requests to add, change or drop courses are not valid in the summer school.

c) Attendance of students in summer school is compulsory.

Students who cannot attend the exams for a valid reason are provided with a make-up exam. For the same reason, upon the request of the student, the student's Summer School registration may be cancelled with the decision of the relevant Faculty Administrative Board.

d) The tuition fee for Summer School is determined per course.

e) In Summer Schools, full-time teaching staff must teach at least one course.

### **Principles for taking courses outside the University of Kyrenia:**

**Article-4 a )** In order for students to take courses from other universities in the summer term, the student's grade point average (CGPA) must be equal to or greater than 2.0.

b) In a summer term, it is possible to take a maximum of 2 courses from other universities, provided that they are not offered at University of Kyrenia. The total number of courses taken from universities other than University of Kyrenia cannot exceed 5.

c) A course offered at University of Kyrenia in summer school cannot be taken at another university.

d) The language of instruction of the course to be taken outside the University of Kyrenia must be appropriate to the programme at the University of Kyrenia.

e) In order to take courses from another university, the student must apply to the Head of the Department with a justified petition at the end of the Spring semester. In the petition, the name and address of the university where the course can be taken and the courses to be taken and the course contents should be shown. After the Head of the Department accepts the petition, it must be approved by the Dean of the Faculty. The deadline for submitting a petition to take courses from another university is the day of enrolment in the University of Kyrenia summer school.

f) Students who take courses from another university must submit the transcript of the courses taken at the end of the summer school to the relevant Department Head of University of Kyrenia.

g) Only the student's grades of 2.5 out of 4 and above are valid for courses taken from another university.

h) Courses with compulsory laboratory cannot be taken from other universities.

i) When taking courses from another university is finalised; the student is obliged to pay the tuition fee determined by the University of Kyrenia for that semester.

### **Enforcement:**
