

## **UNIVERSITY OF KYRENIA GRADUATION MEDALS APPLICATION PRINCIPLES**

### **Objective**

This code of practice is the regulation of the principles of awarding medals to successful graduates of University of Kyrenia (UG) undergraduate programmes in order to motivate them and to indicate that they are appreciated for their achievements.

### **A. MEDAL ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS**

A.1a. Those who are entitled to graduate from the undergraduate programme must have studied at least half of their education period at GU.

A.1b. For medical students, this period is at least 4 years.

A.2. Grade point average calculation is based on all years of education. Transfer students' transferred grades and credits are included in the calculation.

A.3. Graduates who have received any disciplinary penalty during their education will be included in the medal ranking.

does not participate. The situation of those who receive a written warning only in the first two semesters can be decided by the Faculty Executive Board.

A.4. The medal is awarded personally to the deserving person.

A.5. No award is given if the student's graduation grade point average is below 3.00, has failed the make-up exam, has taken a conditional graduation exam, or has exceeded the normal education period.

A.6. In order to be awarded, there must be at least 10 active students in that class of the graduated programme.

### **B. MEDALS**

B.1. Faculty/School Medals: Awarded to the first, second and third place winners of the Faculty/School.

B.2. Gold Medal is awarded to the Faculty/School winner, Silver Medal to the runner-up and Bronze Medal to the third.

B.3. Faculty/School medals are awarded by the Founding Rector, the Chairman of the Board of Trustees or the Rector.

B.4. The medal for Division First Place is awarded only to the Division First Place winner.

B.5. The first, second or third place winner also receives the Faculty medal, while the first, second or third place winner receives only the Faculty/School medal.

B.6. The medal for First Place is awarded by the Dean or Head of Department.
