



**UNIVERSITY OF GUINEA**  
**REGULATION ON PROMOTION AND APPOINTMENT TO TEACHING**  
**STAFF**

**Scope**

**Article-1** This Regulation regulates the conditions for the promotion and appointment of academic staff to the titles of "**Assistant Professor**", "**Associate Professor**", and "**Professor**" and the principles regarding the use of titles acquired at other universities.

**Basis**

**Article-2** This regulation is based on the "TRNC Higher Education Institutions Regulation on Promotion and Appointment to Academic Membership" made under Article 20 of the Northern Cyprus Higher Education Law No. 65/2005 and the University of Kyrenia Regulation on Academic Organisation and Functioning.

**General Provisions**

**Article-3** The criteria specified in this regulation are decisive only at the preliminary evaluation stage, which will result in the acceptance or rejection of promotion and appointment applications. In the evaluation of applications, the academic qualifications and performance of the candidate must be examined in detail. In this evaluation, the candidate's place and potential in the field of science, his/her contribution to education, his/her professional experience and social contribution, the contributions he/she has made or may make to the objectives of the unit to which he/she applies, his/her contribution to the management and institutional structure of the university and other university services, personal and social characteristics are also taken into consideration in terms of his/her suitability for the position to be appointed.

**Preliminary Evaluation Commission**

**Article-4** Preliminary evaluation commission; It is the commission formed by the Rectorate of University of Kyrenia to fulfil the preliminary evaluation procedures of the applications made. The commission consists of 5 professors from different fields. In case there are not enough faculty members with the title of professor, the commission is formed by assigning as many members as necessary from other units.

Duties of the preliminary evaluation commission;

- a) The scientific studies and other academic activities documented by the candidates in their applications are evaluated quantitatively according to the scoring system in Annex 1 and the minimum requirements system in Annex 2.
- b) Evaluates the file of all applicants within 10 (ten) days from the last day of the application date.
- c) During the 10-day period determined for the evaluation, the Commission officially contacts the relevant candidate and requests information and documents regarding the evaluation in cases where it deems necessary or hesitates. The requested documents must be submitted to the relevant commission within 1 (one) week at the latest. Documents not submitted to the commission within the specified period are not taken into consideration.

**Preliminary evaluation criteria**

**Article-5** At the preliminary evaluation stage, the application files of the candidates must be prepared in a way to take into account the "University of Kyrenia Academic Promotion and Appointment Criteria Annex-1 (Score table)" and Annex-2 (Minimum Requirements for Basic Fields of Educational Sciences and Teacher Training, Science-Mathematics, Engineering, Health Sciences, Social Administrative and Humanities, Philology, Architecture, Law). The points specified in the table in Annex-1 are the minimum points for appointment and promotion to the academic staff of University of Kyrenia.

**Article-6** University of Kyrenia may define and apply different criteria for the relevant basic field or fields within the framework of the model in Annex-2, in line with the objectives of Annex-1 of the score levels applicable to academic promotion and appointment. In order for such different criteria to be applied, they

must be approved by the Senate. The distribution of duties and authorisations regarding which units can define different criteria for which basic fields is determined by the Rectorate.

Appointment and promotion to faculty membership in Vocational Schools are made by the Rectorate with the same procedures and principles.

**Article-7** At the preliminary evaluation stage, 1 (one) electronic and 1 printed file is submitted to the rectorate together with the original of the candidate's application petition. In addition, the application files of all internal or external candidates prepared as specified in **Article 5** are sent digitally to the members of the Preliminary Evaluation Commission separately by the candidate.

**Article-8** The Promotion and Appointment Criteria determined by the University Senate determine the minimum level required for the academic units of the University of Kyrenia, and the fact that the candidate has passed the preliminary evaluation according to these criteria cannot be accepted as an acquired right. The University Senate reserves the right to make changes in the criteria depending on the developments.

### **Applications**

**Article-9** In order for the appointment and promotion applications of the candidates to be processed, there must be a need for a staff member with this qualification in the unit applied for, and the Rectorate must have given approval for the allocation of a staff member with this title.

Before submitting an application, each candidate must evaluate his/her own work in accordance with the criteria set out in **Article 5** and, if the prescribed conditions are met, submit an application.

If there are missing documents in the promotion and appointment application files of the candidates, their applications will not be taken into consideration.

### **Application Requirements**

**Article-10** University of Kyrenia faculty members and staff who fulfil the application conditions for professorship, associate professorship and assistant professorship, except for the minimum period of time required to work in the relevant field, may make their applications in the previous application period in which they have not yet completed their minimum period of time, if they will complete their minimum period of time between the promotion and appointment application periods held twice a year. The evaluation processes of the applications made within this framework are initiated after the completion of five (5) years for applications for the title of professor and three (3) years for applications for the title of associate professor.

### **Promotion and Appointment to Assistant Professorship**

**Article-11** In order to apply for assistant professorship;

It is essential to have a doctorate degree or to be a specialist in medicine, dentistry, pharmacy and veterinary medicine or to have gained proficiency in one of the branches of art to be determined by the GÜ Senate.

**Article-12** Those who fulfil the conditions stipulated in Article 2 of this Regulation;

They must have received the training of trainers organised by universities,

Those who have been working at GÜ for more than one (1) year must have published at least one (1) article under the name of GÜ, and those who have been working for less than one (1) year must have published at least one (1) article in journals within the scope of 1A, 1B and 1C under the name of a different institution.

**Article-13** In order to be appointed as an assistant professor, it is required to have a foreign language score of at least 55 from YDS or YÖKDİL or equivalent foreign language score from exams approved by YÖDAK and/or YÖK, or a minimum score of 55 from the graduate foreign language exam organised by the Rectorate of GÜ. (The foreign language documents to be submitted must have a foreign language exemption of at least one year including the application date. Foreign language certificates approved by YÖK have a maximum of 5 years exemption in accordance with the equivalence table of our University).

**Article- 14** Candidates who apply for assistant professorship and who are approved by the GÜ. Preliminary Evaluation Commission submit 1 printed and 1 electronic file to the GÜ. Rectorate

**Article-15** Together with the application files, a petition stating the unit (department / department / department of art / branch of art, if any) and the field to be evaluated and a declaration stating that there are no missing documents in the application file should be submitted as a separate file.

### **Application File for Promotion and Appointment to Assistant Professor**

- Curriculum Vitae in YÖK Format,
- A copy of the Annex 3 form, completed and marked as required
- Documents proving that the candidate's articles are scanned in SCIE, SSCI, ACHI, ESCI, SCOPUS, TR index,
- Doctorate diploma, certificate of specialisation or proficiency in art, and if available, certificate of assistant professorship,
- A sample of the candidate's work,
- Final acceptance certificate or DOI number for accepted but not yet published works on the date of application.
- Foreign language certificate (original, notarised copy or certified by GÜ Education Unit)
- Training of Trainer certificate,
- Printing contract if the publication is a book,
- It is mandatory to attach documents proving citations and refereeing.

**Article-16** The dean of the faculties, the directors of the institutes or colleges affiliated to the rectorate, one of whom is the director of that unit and one of whom is from outside GÜ, establishes a jury of 3 people to examine the conditions of the assistant professor candidate or candidates approved by the preliminary examination commission. The jury consists of three professors and/or associate professors related to the field of science in which the candidates apply. The dean's office or directorate sends a copy of the candidate's application file for promotion and appointment to assistant professor, which has the content defined in **Article 15**, to the jury members electronically (e-mail or flash memory) and asks them to submit their written opinions in a report. The dean or the relevant director presents the opinions at the first Faculty Administrative Board and/or School Administrative Board meeting after receiving all written opinions and receives separate opinions about the candidate or candidates. If more than one candidate applies for a vacancy, the Board of Directors states its preference with justification. The dean or director submits the decision of the Board of Directors to the rector together with the file containing opinions and recommendations. Based on this report, the Board of Directors decides on the appointment of the applicant to the assistant professorship. Appointment procedures are carried out by the Rectorate.

## Promotion and Appointment to Associate Professorship

**Article- 17** The following conditions are required for promotion and appointment as Associate Professor;  
a) Obtaining the title of doctorate, specialist in medicine, dentistry, pharmacy and veterinary medicine or proficiency in art

a) To have worked full-time in a higher education institution for at least 2 (two) years,

b) To have worked in the relevant field of science for at least three (3) years,

c) In order to be appointed as an associate professor, it is required to have a foreign language score of at least 55 from YDS or YÖKDİL or equivalent foreign language score from exams approved by YÖDAK and/or YÖK, or a minimum score of 55 from the graduate foreign language exam organised by the Rectorate of GÜ. (The foreign language documents to be submitted must have a foreign language exemption of at least one year including the application date. Foreign language certificates approved by the Council of Higher Education (YÖK) are exempt for a maximum of 5 years in accordance with the equivalence table of our University). [In accordance with this regulation, foreign language documents previously submitted to the Rectorate in order to be appointed as Assistant Professor are also valid for application to this position within the valid exemption periods],

d) For faculty members and staff of University of Kyrenia, to have published at least 2 articles in journals within the scope of 1A, 1B and 1C under the name of GÜ.

e) To be approved by the "GÜ Preliminary Evaluation Commission" according to the scoring system in Appendix 1 and the minimum requirements system in Appendix 2 in terms of the quantity of scientific works and other academic activities.

**Article- 18** Examination for Promotion to Associate Professorship;

Candidates applying for the associate professorship exam submit 1 printed and 1 electronic file including their CV, scientific studies and works to the Rectorate of GÜ.

**Article- 19** Scientific Jury for Promotion to Associate Professorship Examination,

a) The Science Jury consists of 5 full and 2 substitute members, the majority of whom are selected from among the professors working at other universities, according to the expertise and research subject of the science branch to which the candidate applies. The GÜ Board of Directors decides who the science jury will consist of. If there are not enough members in the same branch of science or if the characteristics of the candidate's branch of science or specialisation and research subjects make it compulsory, jury members can be selected from nearby branches of science.

b) A copy of the candidate's application file for promotion to associate professor with the content defined in **Article 20** is submitted to the jury members electronically (e-mail or flash memory).

c) The members of the scientific jury prepare comprehensive reports on the originality, relevance to the branch of science, contribution to the branch of science and integrity of the scientific works presented in the candidate's file before the meeting. The Science Jury convenes in full number, elects a chairman from among themselves, evaluates the submitted reports and decides positively or negatively by majority vote.

d) The scientific jury subjects the candidate, about whom it makes a positive decision, to an oral examination or, if necessary, also to a practical and applied examination. In the oral examination, the candidate's knowledge of the discipline to which the candidate has applied is evaluated based on the works submitted by the candidate, and the candidate is decided to be successful or unsuccessful by unanimous or majority vote.

e) Candidates whose scientific works are found sufficient but who fail the oral examination may take the oral examination for the second time at least 6 months later. Candidates who fail the oral exam for the second time can take the associate professorship exam again only after a full year.

**Article-20** The science jury notifies the candidate orally and in writing (together with the reports of the jury members and a detailed examination report) to the Rectorate of the University. The GÜ Board of Directors takes the decision to promote the candidate to associate professorship in line with the decision of the scientific jury. Associate Professorship success certificate is given to the candidate by the Rectorate of the University.

### Application File for Promotion to Associate Professor

The candidate must submit a petition to the Rectorate of the University of Kyrenia, together with the application files, stating the unit (department / department / department of art / branch of art, if any) and

the Academic Title they want to be promoted and a declaration stating that there is no missing document in the application file.

- Curriculum Vitae in YÖK Format,
- A copy of the Annex 3 form, completed and marked as required
- Documents proving that the candidate's articles are scanned in SCIE, SSCI, ACHI, ESCI, SCOPUS, TR index,
- Doctorate diploma, specialisation certificate or proficiency in art certificate,
- One copy of each of his works,
- Final acceptance certificate or DOI number for accepted but not yet published works on the date of application. (At least 70% of the applicant's articles within the scope of the compulsory condition of the title applied for must be published)
- Foreign language certificates (original, notarised copy or certified by the Education Unit)
- Training of Trainer certificate (for applicants from universities other than University of Kyrenia),
- Printing contract if the publication is a book,
- It is mandatory to attach documents proving citations and refereeing.

### **Appointment as Associate Professor**

**Article-21** In order to determine the status and scientific or artistic qualifications of the candidate/candidates applying for the appointment of associate professor, the Board of Directors of the GÜ constitutes a jury consisting of professors from other universities, one of whom is the director of that unit, related to the field of science or art of the announced staff. The jury consists of 3 full and 1 substitute member. The jury members examine the documents in the file submitted by the candidate/candidates and prepare a report separately for each candidate, and if there is more than one candidate applying for appointment to the staff, they state their preferences. In these reports, the scientific or artistic qualifications and works of the candidates are evaluated, their managerial, constructive and developmental qualities and their efforts to train scientists and artists are stated in detail. The Board of Directors of GÜ decides on the appointment of the applicant based on these reports related to the promotion to associate professorship. Appointment procedures are carried out by the Rectorate.

**Article-22** Candidates submit 1 printed and 1 electronic file to the Rectorate of GÜ.

**Article-23** When submitting their application files, candidates submit a petition stating the unit (department / department / department of art / branch of art, if any) and the field to be evaluated and a declaration stating that there are no missing documents in the application file.

**Article-24** In the event that the field of application of the candidate applying for the appointment of Associate Professor is different from the department and/or the relevant department at the University of Kyrenia, the written opinion of the head of the department to which the candidate will apply is taken.

### **Application File for Appointment as Associate Professor**

The application file for appointment to associate professorship includes all the documents included in the application file for promotion to associate professorship and **the Associate Professorship Certificate in addition.**

### **Promotion and Appointment to Professorship**

**Article-25** The following conditions are required for promotion and appointment to professorship:

- a) Having worked in the relevant field of science for at least five (5) years, including at least three (3) years full-time in a Higher Education Institution, and having published at least 3 articles in journals within the scope of 1A, 1B and 1C under the name of GÜ for candidates who are faculty members and staff of University of Kyrenia.
- b) To be found appropriate by the "GÜ Preliminary Evaluation Commission" according to the scoring system in Appendix 1 and the minimum requirements system in Appendix 2 in terms of the quantity of

scientific studies and other academic activities.

c) To have given original works in his/her field of science and to have practical studies in branches that have an application area.

e) In order to be appointed to the professorship; a foreign language score of at least 55 from YDS or YÖKDİL or equivalent foreign language score from exams approved by YÖDAK and/or YÖK, or a minimum score of 55 from the graduate foreign language exam organised by the Rectorate of GÜ. (The foreign language documents to be submitted must have a foreign language exemption of at least one year including the application date. Foreign language documents approved by the Council of Higher Education (YÖK) are exempt for a maximum of 5 years in accordance with the equivalence table of our University). [In accordance with this regulation, foreign language documents previously submitted to the Rectorate in order to be appointed as Associate Professor are also valid for application to this position within the valid exemption periods],

**Article-26** 1 printed and 1 electronic file is delivered to the Rectorate of University of Kyrenia.

**Article-27** When submitting their application files, candidates submit a petition stating the unit (department / department / department of art / branch of art, if any) and the field to be evaluated and a declaration stating that there are no missing documents in the application file.

#### **Application File for Promotion and Appointment to Professorship**

- Curriculum Vitae in YÖK Format,
- A copy of the Annex 3 form, completed and marked as required
- Documents proving that the candidate's articles are scanned in SCIE, SSCI, ACHI, ESCI, SCOPUS, TR index,
- A copy of the doctoral diploma or specialisation certificate,
- Associate Professorship certificate,
- One copy of his works before and after associate professorship,
- Final acceptance certificate or DOI number for accepted but not yet published works on the date of application. (At least 70% of the applicant's articles within the scope of the compulsory condition of the title applied for must be published)
- Foreign language certificate (original, notarised copy or certified by the Education Unit)
- Training of Trainer certificate (for applicants from universities other than University of Kyrenia)
- Printing contract if the publication is a book,
- It is mandatory to attach documents proving citations and refereeing.

**Article-28** In the event that the field of application of the candidate applying for professorship is different from the department and/or the relevant department at the University of Kyrenia, the written opinion of the head of the department to which the candidate will apply is taken.

**Article-29** In order to determine the status and scientific or artistic qualifications of the candidates applying for professorship, the Board of Directors of GÜ shall select 3 full and 1 substitute member, one of whom shall be the director of that unit, from among the professors from other universities related to the field of science or art of the advertised position. These members examine the documents in the dossier submitted by the candidate or candidates and prepare a report separately for each candidate, and if there is more than one candidate applying for appointment, they state their preferences. In these reports, the scientific or artistic qualifications and works of the candidates are evaluated, their managerial, constructive and developmental qualities and their efforts in raising men of science and art are stated in detail. The Board of Directors of the Graduate School decides on the appointment of the applicant associate professor to the professorship on the basis of these reports. Appointment procedures are carried out by the Rectorate.

**Article-30** A copy of the candidates' application file for promotion and appointment to professorship with the content defined in **Article 27** is sent to the jury members electronically (e-mail or flash memory).

**Article-31** Candidates who apply for promotion and appointment to assistant professorship, associate professorship and professorship positions, but are found unsuccessful by the scientific and appointment

jury formed after their applications are accepted, cannot apply for the same position again until one year has passed.

### **Open and Reappointment**

**Article-32** Applications for open and reappointment to professorship, associate professorship and assistant professorship positions are evaluated by the Rectorate of the University of Kyrenia and the appointment procedures are carried out by the Rectorate.

### **Open and reappointment application file**

- The application petition submitted by the candidate to the Rectorate (indicating which branch of science he/she is applying for),
- Candidate's Curriculum Vitae (CV) and list of works,

### **Enforcement**

**Article-33** This regulation shall be applied as of **November 2024**.

## EXPLANATIONS

### 1-Publication must be in indexed journals related to the candidate's field of application;

- a. Printed,
- b. Electronically published
- c. It should be a research article, review, "short communication=brief communication", case report, technical note, letter to the editor, letter to the editor, congress abstract/full text, book review, which has received DOI for publication and whose full text has been published electronically.

### 2- Main Author ;

- a. Name in a single-authored article
- b. The first ranked author among the authors of the article
- c. The author and supervisor(s) of the thesis in the publication produced from graduate theses (it must be documented that it is a thesis publication).
- d. If the author order is alphabetical, the primary author is determined according to the declaration signed by all authors (Appendix 4).

### 3-Corresponding Author;

- a- The senior author, who usually provides intellectual input and designs and approves the protocols to be followed in the study
- b- If the responsible author is not the first name, this author is given an additional score of 10% of the total score of the work.

### 4-Book/Book Section;

- a. The book must be related to the field of basic science/art to which the candidate applies.
- b. Encyclopaedia chapters/articles are considered as book chapters.
- c. Points can only be awarded for authorship/translation of two chapters in the same book.
- d. If the author of the book chapter is the same person as the editor, points can be obtained from only one chapter author in addition to the editorial points.
- e. The "Sense Ranking of Academic Publishers" classification in the year the book was published is valid.

### 5-Atf

- a. The maximum score under this heading is 20 points.
- a. References to the candidate's own publications and reciprocal citations are not taken into consideration.
- b. The citation score is calculated as specified in the table.
- c. The candidate must document the citations scored
- d. Each publication receives one citation score regardless of the number of times it is cited in the place of publication.
- d. For assistant professorship; citations to all publications of the candidate are evaluated. For associate professorship; all publications of the candidate, citations made after obtaining the doctorate degree and specialisation degree in medicine, dentistry, pharmacy and veterinary medicine are evaluated. For professorship; citations made to all publications of the candidate after the date of receiving the title of associate professor are evaluated.

### 6-Managed and Completed Graduate Thesis

In case there is more than one supervisor, "main author points" are shared.

### 7-Projects

Projects are considered "completed" only in the presence of an acceptance letter stating that they have been successfully completed.

### 8-Patent

Patents that have been registered by international or national patent institutions; that have a research report stating that the invention is new and contains an inventive step; that have been implemented in industry or commercialised are accepted. The patent score is divided by the number of idea right holders.

### **9-Impact Factor (IF) (Impact Factor);**

For articles published in journals within the scope of SCIE, SSCI, AHCI and ESCI, the effect of "Impact Factor" on the score is as follows;

$$\text{Net Score} = \text{Score indicated in the table} + (2 \times \text{Impact factor})$$

The Impact factor of the specified journal on the date of publication of the article is taken as the basis for scoring.

### **10-Multicentre and/or Multinational Studies;**

a-Studies conducted in four or more centres are considered as multicentre and multinational studies.

b-In multi-centre studies, works published in journals with an Impact Factor (IF) of 5 and above are evaluated.

c-In different multi-centre / different multi-disciplinary studies (article authorship, book / book chapter authorship or book / book chapter translation, joint scientific studies and citations such as awards and patents), the score specified in the table is accepted separately for each centre / discipline and divided as in the sample calculations below. Different centres / different disciplines are different faculties, different departments of different universities or different faculties of the same university.

d-Different branches of science within the same department are not different centres/different disciplines.

e- The department of the first author in the study is accepted as the main centre / discipline, and the points deserved by the authors working in the main centre / discipline are calculated as in the sample calculation below.

f-Disciplines other than the department of the first author are considered as secondary centres/disciplines. In the calculation of the points deserved by the authors working in the secondary centre / discipline, the score of the first author of the study is taken as the basis and this score is divided equally among the authors working in each secondary centre / discipline. g-If there is only one author in the secondary centre / discipline, this author receives 80% of the score received by the first author of the study.

h- For international collaborative publications, the candidate receives the same score as the first author.

### **Sample Calculation in Multi-centre Studies**

EXAMPLE:1

1. A. AHCI, SCI Expanded, SCI and SSCI indexed article indexed in Web of Science;

A centre (Main centre / discipline) : 15 points

First name in centre A:  $15 \times 80\% = 12$  points

Second name in centre A:  $15 \times 40\% = 6$  points

Centre B (Secondary centre/discipline) : 12 points [Points awarded to the first author of the study]

Each of the authors :  $(12 \times 80\%) \div 3 = 3.2$  points

Centre C (secondary centre/discipline) : 12 points [Points awarded to the first author of the study]

Each of the authors :  $(12 \times 80\%) \div 3 = 3.2$  points

\*If there is only one author in the secondary centre(s),  $9 \times 80\% = 7.2$  points (80% of the points received by the first author of the study)

\*Impact Factor (IF) is added to the scores indicated in the table (see explanations, item 9).
